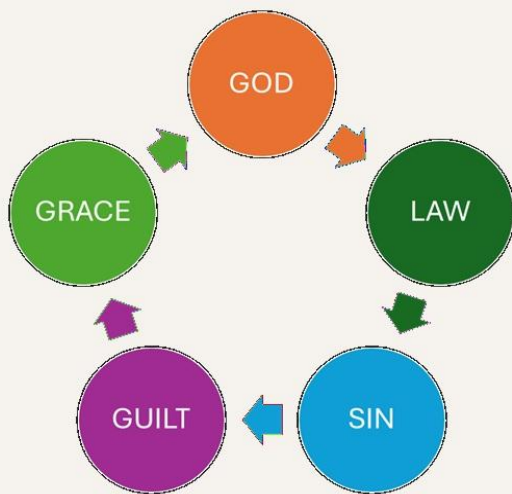

**The Broken Vase**

Consider this parable. A small child is playing and accidently breaks a beautiful ceramic vase that is treasured by her father. The vase is shattered into many pieces. The child is distraught knowing that her father will be angry with her. The child does her best, however to fix the broken vase. She gathers tape and glue and begins re-piecing the cherished treasure back together. After much glue and a mile of tape, the job is finished. For a fleeting moment she thinks no one will notice, but then she realizes that this will never be so and the tears flow anew. Her crying attracts the attention of mother who investigates and comforts the child. She says to the child “We have to tell daddy, but don’t worry, I’ll be there with you”.

The mother and child meet the father who is busy in the den. As soon as he sees the shattered vase his face betrays his feelings. Shock and anger and followed by disappointment. He knows immediately what has happened. A wink from the child’s mother, however, causes him to withhold his feelings.

The child is standing there with mothers hand on her shoulder, tears flowing from her eyes, with this taped ceramic mess in her hands, dripping with glue. There are a few pieces missing as well. Instead of anger, the father takes the broken vase from her trembling hands of the child and hugs her. Now the tears pour out. “I’m so sorry”. “It’s OK” says the father. “It’s OK”

Hello, my name is Abigail Ries. I am 20 years old and have recently joined a Pro-Life ministry called Protect Life Michigan, which recruits, equips, and deploys students to be effective pro-life leaders who change minds on abortion right here in MI. Over the course of this summer, I will be undertaking an intense full-time internship to change minds and save lives, alongside over 50 young pro-life activists.

I will be dedicating this summer to activism, such as:

- Deep Canvassing - Interns go door-to-door, having thoughtful conversations about abortion. Using empathy and active listening, they help shift hearts and minds, one conversation at a time.
- Street Outreach - Interns set up displays in public spaces and engage passersby in respectful, thoughtful conversations about abortion - bringing the pro-life message to people who might not hear otherwise. Our interns are equipped to share the truth with clarity and compassion, thereby fostering respectful and thoughtful dialogue.
- Sidewalk Counselling - Interns offer compassionate support outside abortion clinics, sharing hope and life-affirming options with women at a critical moment.
- Banner & Lit. Drop - Interns help spread the pro-life message through impactful banners in high-traffic areas and by distributing literature in key neighborhoods, sparking awareness and inviting reflection on the dignity of every human life.

The Lord has called me to do this work, to serve in the pro-life movement by being a voice for the unborn and to put my talents to the best of my abilities. I have full confidence that the strategies PLM uses, along with the graces from God, will bring about every significant change

to this cause in our lifetime. I have so much hope that we can bring an end to abortion. But to do this, I need people to help support me financially.
