In Matthew chapter nine, Jesus says "The harvest is great but the workers are few" and his is true in any ministry. If you are looking for a way to draw closer to Jesus, then helping those

around you is the best way to accomplish this. Perhaps you are drawn to help at a soup kitchen, or a homeless shelter. Or maybe - just maybe - you've wondered....

What Is It Like To Do Prison Ministry?

I remember the first time I went to jail about twelve years ago. I was nervous, and completely out of my element because I'd never been in jail before and although I've seen jails on television and in movies, it's just not the same as the real thing. The deacon, the priest and I walked into the common room of the cell block and began setting up for mass. The priest with us that day was a retired priest named Father Joe, who was preparing to celebrate Mass in the cell that day. Father Joe was wearing his alb (pronounced "all-buh" - a white robe worn by the priest during Mass) so you could not see his Roman collar. Soon, the prisoners began filing in one by one. The deacon and I shook each man's hand and greeted them as they entered. I especially recall one inmate. He was dressed in prison orange (as they all were), and he had a big, bushy, full beard and mustache and was about 6'5" or 6'6" tall and weighed around 300+ pounds (you could say that he stood out).

What If I'm Not Healed?

Occasionally this can happen, but what does it mean? Here are some common misconceptions:

1. God changed His mind
2. God is teasing/makng fun of me
3. I'm not worthy

All of the statements above are false.

I've prayed for a lot of people - and I've seen a lot of people healed. Then again, I've prayed for some and then attended their funerals too. In the end, I don't know why God does what He does but I do know one thing for certain, it is better to pray than to not pray.

If you receive prayer (from anyone) and are not healed, the best thing to do is to pray again. If you still do not receive healing, then pray once more. If you **still** do not receive healing, then pray again, and again, and again and again. Jesus tells us to knock and keep knocking (Mt 7:7) and to make a pest out of ourselves before the Holy Throne of God (Lk 18:1-8).
